## Project case study 3: The MDD - Msheireb Doha Downtown

The MDD project aims to redevelop, regenerate and conserve the historical downtown of Doha. It's a 31 hectare, mixed-use development situated in the centre of the city.

5 subcontractors were failing to reach the target. 2 Cut & Bend factories, 2 big detailing companies and 1 company with an in-house detailing team. Their rebar shop drawings kept getting rejected by the consultant.

Penalties were received due to delayed casting of one of the main blocks and there were serious delays on site.

AABCO joined the project in 2017. We created a special, ICU team. A highly focused, intensive care unit with the sole mission of succeeding.

This was done to ensure unification of parameters and high communication in the preparatory stage of the project. In this way, we have paved the way for the shop drawing production phase, and enabled our highly skilled engineers, coordinators, and quality controllers to give the project the intensive care it deserves.
